THEATRE : Victory Gardens Theater :

Chicago's theater community spawned modern improvisational theater. Victory Gardens Theater was founded in 1974, when seven artists created a company to play outside Chicago Loop. It is situated on Lincoln Avenue, in Chicago (Illinois). The theater's first production, *The Velvet Rose* was played on October 9, 1974. Victory Gardens Theater has dedicated itself to playwrights and their works as well as emphasizing the development of an ethnically and culturally diverse community of artists. Now the playwrights Circle Mirror Transformation is being played in this theater.



DANCE : Hubbard Street Dance Chicago:

Hubbard Street Dance Chicago is an American dance company based in Chicago. HSDC was founded in 1977 by the dancer and choreographer : Lou Conte. HSDC is a contemporary company based on jazz dancing. Its debut in New York City was in May 1983. The company has appeared in 44 states and 17 countries at celebrated dance venues. HSDC has collaborated with various orchestras. Now, they are performing ballets.



MUSICAL : Chicago Musical :

The original Broadway production opened June 3rd, 1975 at the 46th street Theatre. Bob Fosse choreographed it. The musical is based on the play of the same name by Maurine Dallas Watkins, which dates from 1926. It is about criminals and crimes she reported on. The music is by John Kander and the lyrics are by Fred Ebb. It is played by Catherine Zeta-Jones, Renee Zellweger, Richard Gere, John C. Reilly and Queen Latifah. *Chicago Musical* has wowed audiences all around the world, from Mexico City to Moscow, from Sao Paulo to South Africa.
