


The movies from Chicago




Many movies were filmed in Chicago. We will work on 3 of this movies, filmed from 1969 to 2009. This movies will be i-Robot, Backdraft and Public Enemies.

The first movie we'll work on is I,Robot.



I,Robot is a movie filmed by Alex Proyas in 2004. The most famous actors who played in that are Will Smith and Shia LaBeouf. It's inspired by Isaac Asimov's books. It's a Sci-fi film, who happening in 2035... The movie tell the story of Dell Spooner, a policeman who investigates to find the murderer of Alfred Lanning, the "father" of the robots. But the robots must obey to 3 laws: they can't kill humans, they have to obey to humans' orders, and they must protect their own lives without disobey to the previous laws. The place of anthropomorphism in this movie is very important. The film during 115 minutes. It had a great success. Will Smith has Dell Spooner, Shia LaBeouf has Farber, and Bruce Greenwood has Lieutenant John Bergin .

The second movie we'll work on is Backdraft.



Backdraft was made in 1991 by Ron Howard is a movie with Robert De Niro about a fire... The story is that Brian and Steven McCaffrey is the son of a firefighter heroes who died in a fire. While Steven has successfully followed in the footsteps of his father, Brian, for his part, separated from the medium. He never the less attempted a return to the profession, but Steven, skeptical about the motives of his brother, will put tremendous demand. In parallel, lieutenant Donald Rimgale is called to investigate into arsons activated by means of a substance conscript trychtichlorate. These last ones aim at killing the former co-workers of the mayor. Kurt Russell play the Lieutenant Stephen McCaffrey and Dennis McCaffrey; William Baldwin plays Brian McCaffrey and Robert de Niro plays Lieutenant Donald Rimgale.

The third film we'll work on is Public Enemies.



Public Enemies was directed by Michael Mann. It went out the 8 July 2009. It is pulled by the book of Bryan Burrough. It inspired by John Dillinger's history, a bank robber except standards who, from 1930s, found his vocation. FBI considered him as the public enemy number one and asked to Melvin Purvis to pursue him. Having made his accomplices of the federal Penitentiary of the Indiana escape, John Dillinger is going to take refuge with a small farm where he will be safe. One evening, by going out with all his band, he meets Billie Frechette, of French and Indian origin. He invites him to follow him through America. She eventually accepts, but he is arrested by an agent of FBI before their departure. Once imprisoned in a prison in Indiana, he

manages one more time to escape thanks to a forgery to revolver. He does not turn to see her at once. He holds up a bank where, by going out, he is fired in the arm. Johnny Depp play John Dillinger, Christian Bale play Melvin Purvis and Marion Cotillard play Billie Frechette.
